Please refer to subject cited above, the Council has received email on 1st August, 2017 from Shri Feroz Ahmed, Under-Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of J&K, Srinagar regarding postponement of counseling scheduled from 4th - 6th August, 2017 at Srinagar. Accordingly, AICTE has postponed the counseling in the State of J&K during this period. SMS messages were also sent to all the students regarding postponement.

In the meanwhile, the Council has received information on the portal that numbers of seats under PMSSS are still vacant due to left-over or non-reporting of the students. The PMSSS Cell discussed the matter in detail for immediate remedial measures to benefit the students and it is decided that 2nd and 3rd Round of Counseling for the left-over seats will be done through on-line process as the time is very less.

After selecting one of the options, allotment letter will be generated automatically and will be available in the students login.

All the students are directed to join the allotted Colleges before 14th August, 2017.

It may be noted that documents in original of the students under PMSSS will be verified at the level of allotted Institutions.

Grievance Redressal Mechanism:

The Council has decided to depute two staff members each from AICTE Headquarters at Jammu as well as Srinagar Counseling Centers during 8th -14th August, 2017. The details of the officials will be sent separately to Nodal Centers. Nodal Principals are requested to provide them all infrastructure and depute two faculty members along with staff and help them in setting-up offices for resolving the queries received from the students.
